Common Reed or Phragmites Options for Control

Key identifying traits • Leaves of Common reed grow alternately along the top half of the stem • Leaves are flat and strap-like; an inch or more wide, tapering to a long point, growing up to 2 feet long • Erect, smooth stems can grow as high as 6 to 15 feet tall • Silky inflorescence grow at the tops of the stems, draping to one side growing one to two
